Summary

The purpose of this circular memorandum is to inform schools of the findings of the Survey on Laboratory Accidents in Secondary Schools in the 2014/2015 school year.

Details

- 2. As one of the ways to monitor the standard of safety in secondary school science laboratories, surveys of laboratory accidents occurring at schools were conducted since the 1995/1996 school year. The survey for the 2014/2015 school year has been completed and the findings are summarised in the report at http://cd1.edb.hkedcity.net/cd/science/laboratory/safety/Report_of_the_Survey_on_Laboratory_vaccidents_2014-15_e.pdf. The report provides information on the categories and causes of common laboratory accidents in secondary schools. It also suggests measures by which schools can take to minimise laboratory accidents. Heads of schools are requested to bring the contents of the report to the attention of their science teachers and laboratory technicians.
